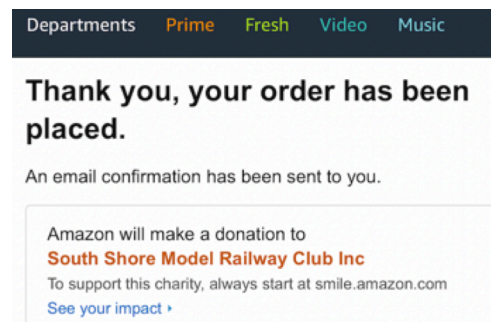

The South Shore Model Railway Club was founded in September 1938 by five rail fans, who built their first layout in a hobby store basement in Quincy, MA. Our 75th anniversary was celebrated in 2013. The layout and Club moved several times and, in 1992, the club moved to our current location in Bare Cove Park in Hingham. After much time, labor, and investment in rehabbing, the new premises have become a "museum", providing displays, educational & historical artifacts, and a train layout.

We have four Open Houses each year, Family & Scout Night in beginning of January, a Spring Show weekend in mid March, a Summer Show the beginning of August, and Fall Show weekend at the end of October.
